

## **CITY OF WAYNE – MMFLA NOTICE**

The City of Wayne will begin accepting MMFLA applications on Tuesday, May 29, 2018, at 10:00 a.m. for businesses in the five medical marijuana facility license types: (1) Grower Facility, (2) Safety Compliance Facility, (3) Provisioning Center, (4) Processor, and (5) Secure Transporter. No more than eight Facility Licenses shall be issued, which shall be limited to the following numbers and types of Licenses: (1) four Provisioning Center Licenses, and (2) a total of four other Licenses from the following categories: Grower Facility, Processor Facility, Secure Transporter Facility, and Safety Compliance Facility. Applications are available on the City website at [www.cityofwayne.com](http://www.cityofwayne.com) and for pick-up at Wayne City Hall.

Applications for new facilities that are subject to the lottery process must be submitted to the City Clerk's office no later than 4:30 p.m. on August 16, 2018. The three (3) existing and approved Medical Marijuana Dispensaries in the City will not be required to participate in the lottery process. Accordingly, only one Provisioning Center lottery designation exists. Applications received after August 16, 2018 will be reviewed after the lottery drawing has been conducted, and will be reviewed and approved in the order received.

Applications for facilities subject to the lottery process will not be reviewed until August 17, 2018. Any application found to be incomplete will be rejected. Multiple applications will not be accepted for the same property address, except for purposes of stacking Grower Facility Licenses as permitted under state law. Otherwise, only one license type will be issued to each property address. Following a complete review of the application and background checks, approved applications will be entered into a lottery drawing, if necessary. If the approved applications do not exceed the allotted license numbers and types, no lottery drawing will be conducted. The lottery will take place at Wayne City Hall. The chosen applicants will have 120 days from the date of approval to show proof of application to the State of Michigan. If the applicant fails to show proof, the approval from the City may be revoked.
