

DUMPSTER ENCLOSURE SPECIFICATIONS

The requirements for dumpster enclosures shall include the following:

1. A permit is required for the construction of a new dumpster enclosure. The structure must comply with the installation standards of the fence ordinance Chapter 1279.00 of the *Codified Ordinance of Wayne*.
2. A plot plan, showing the location of the dumpster enclosure on the lot and all overhead utilities, is required.
3. The enclosure shall be large enough to accommodate the dumpster and be placed on the lot for adequate service from the rubbish company.
4. The enclosure shall be placed on a concrete pad with a minimum concrete depth of four inches (4").
5. The fencing shall be an opaque type material of either wood, concrete, vinyl or chain link with slats. (Wooden fencing must be of the "shadow box design.")
6. The fence height shall fully enclose the dumpster and shall not exceed eight feet (8') in height.
7. The enclosure shall be constructed in such a manner that all structural members, including braces, posts, poles and other projections, shall be on the interior side of the fence.
8. The gates shall be constructed with commercial grade hinges, poles and hasps.
9. The supporting poles at the gates shall be metal with the appropriate diameter to support the gate at least one and five-eighths inches (1-5/8") in diameter.
10. The gates shall have a closing latch and gates must remain closed at all times except during service.
