A regular meeting of the Wayne City Council was held on Tuesday, June 6, 2023, at 7:00 p.m. at the Wayne City Hall, 3355 South Wayne Rd.

Mayor John Rhaesa called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and led the Council and the audience in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

06-23-0147 Motion by Porter, seconded by Dowd and unanimously carried, it was resolved to approve the agenda as presented.

06-23-0148 Motion by Cleereman, seconded by Porter and unanimously carried, it was resolved to approve the minutes of May 16, 2023 as presented.

Wayne Memorial High School Bowling Team was given a plaque in honor of winning the State Championship.

Library Director, Jody Wolak gave a presentation regarding the Library Summer Reading Program.

06-23-0149 Motion by Cleereman, seconded by Dowd and unanimously carried, it was resolved to approve the Police Department purchase of a Mobile Fingerprint Scanner from the sole provider of Dataworks Plus in the amount of \$4,140.00 to be paid from the Department of Justice Grant.

06-23-0150 Motion by Cleereman, seconded by Porter and unanimously carried, it was resolved to approve the Police Department purchase of a United Shield Ballistic Shield from Huron Valley Guns, New Hudson, MI in the amount of \$3,500.00 of which \$1,671.00 will be grant funded and the remainder of the cost to be paid from the Police Department budget.

06-23-0151 Motion by Brock, seconded by Porter and unanimously carried, it was resolved to approve the request from Turn the Towns Teal to hang teal ribbons on trees and/or light poles throughout the Downtown Wayne area on September 1, 2023, and removed no later than September 30, 2023, for ovarian cancer awareness.
