## Our History on Display

Come and learn about Wayne's History in the historic Village Hall built in 1878. In the past, this building served as the Village Hall, Police Station, Fire Station, Junior Achievement Offices and the Chamber of Commerce. The building has been completely restored to its original condition with new windows, fire protection system, new paint, freshened exhibits, and beautiful landscaped gardens.

The Wayne City Council and Wayne Historical Commission are dedicated to the preservation of the building and archives. There are over 100 displays in the museum with information about the early settlers, schools, churches, farming life and early industries.

The archive collection houses many photographs and research on the early families in town.
